VOTER REGISTRATION

Voter registration forms are available through the County Clerk's office at the courthouse in Richmond, at the County Clerk's office at Berea City Hall or online at <http://sos.ky.gov>. You may also register when you renew your driver's license, by mail or through local social service agencies. Voter registration books are closed 28 days before primary and general elections in Kentucky. For information about voting, contact the County Clerk's office at 859.624.4706.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible to vote in Kentucky if you

- are a U.S. citizen and will be 18 years old on or before the general election (if you are 18 by the Nov. general election, you may also vote in the prior May primary election)
- have been a resident of the voting precinct for at least 28 days before the election
- have not been convicted of a felony (unless citizenship has been restored by governor)
- have not been judged mentally incompetent
- do not claim the right to vote anywhere outside of Kentucky
- are properly registered
